RESOLUTION NO. 2025-03 RUBY ROAD – ROAD AIDS FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake owns and maintains the 5,122 feet of Ruby Road, as the Project Information states

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project will consist of rebuilding the road bed and grading gravel to properly shape the road. The 5,122 feet of Ruby Road is to be re-graveled, with 1,200 feet to receive 2 inches of gravel, and 3,922 feet to receive 4 inches of gravel.

WHEREAS, there will be additional costs for ditching and shouldering the road using 2 town dump trucks, 1 front end loader, and 1 wheeled excavator loader, for approximately one 40-hour week.

WHEREAS, the total project cost is \$75,000.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake will contribute \$25,000 worth of labor and machinery.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake's request to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is for \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby agrees to accept funds designated by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to be used for Ruby Road, thus approving Resolution No. 2025-03, as decided to be in the best interest of the town.
